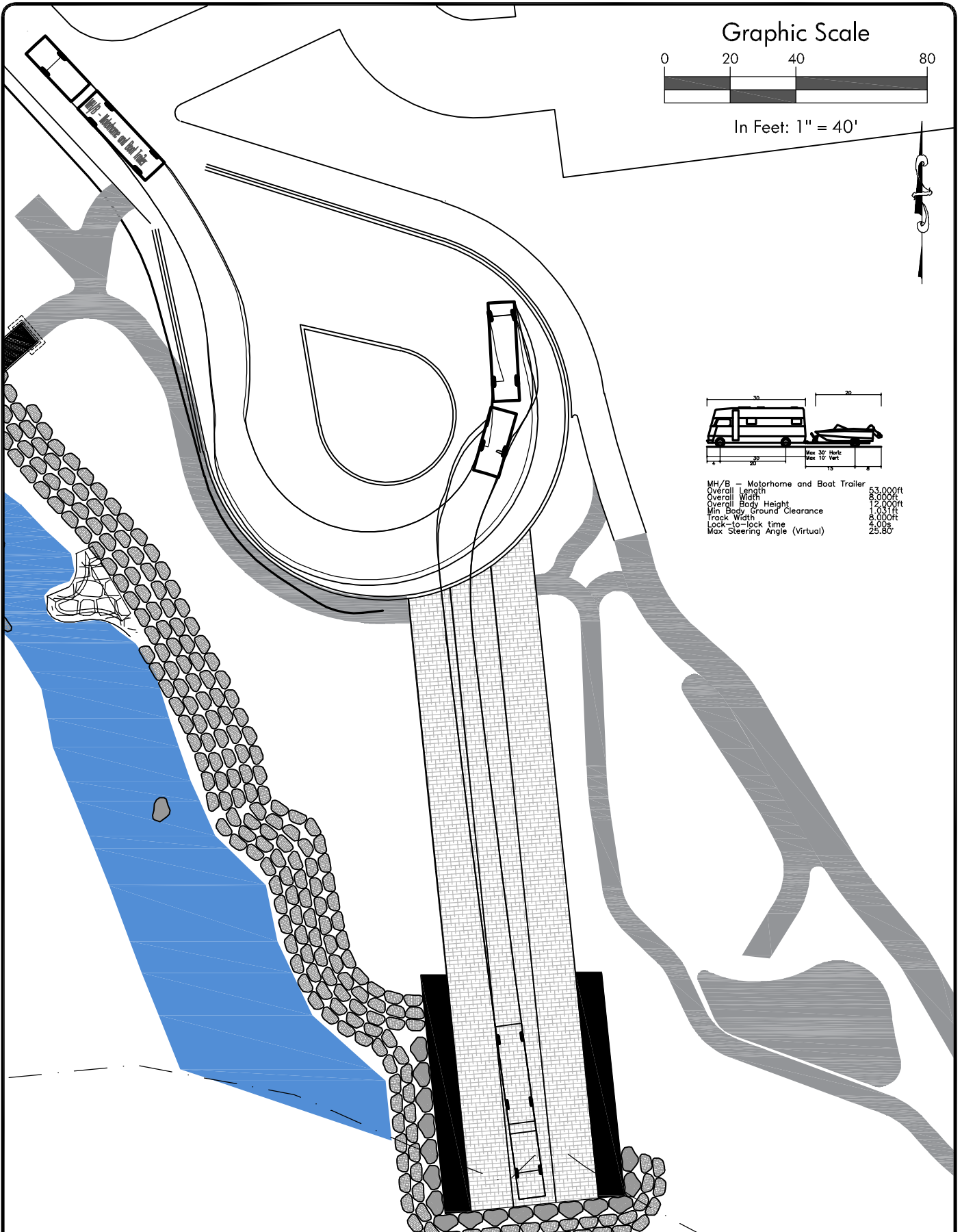

2. Citizen Comments:
 - a. None
3. Introductions
 - a. Two new commission members Tom Gorman and Andi Johnson
4. Approval of November Minutes
 - a. James made the motion to approve the November minutes. Second by Andy M. All in favor none opposed.
5. Two Rivers Park Boat Ramp
 - a. The commission was concerned about the center island impeding traffic and creating problems on the boat ramp. The main concern is boaters not having a proper staging area. Terri had SGM measure and draw a graphic scale on AutoCAD to show the traffic pattern and felt that the center island did not create any issues and that there was enough room to navigate the ramp without removing the island.
 - b. The City will be hiring an attendant in the summer to monitor the ramp.
 - c. Discussion on staging area options.
 - d. Concerns were voiced about the design of the ramp with the center island. Some commissioners felt strongly that the island will create a problem for boaters backing trailers down the ramp. This could also be fixed by realigning the ramp more like it is currently.

- e. There were some safety concerns about location of the crosswalk at the entrance of the boat ramp
 - f. The commissions underlying goal is to create a successful experience for boat ramp users

- a. Park Improvement Plan: Andi & Bill
 - i. The City has begun working on improvements of many parks including Two Rivers, 3 Mile, Veltus, & Sayre
 - b. Two Rivers Park: Bill
 - i. Plan is complete and project has gone out to bid. Projected start for project is February 2018.
 - c. Cost Recovery Processes: Andy & James
 - i. Committee has met a few times and will continue to work on this item
 - d. Community Center Regeneration Project
 - i. Completed projects included the gym floor, roof, resurfacing of dance floor in community rooms and fitness room and a new sound system in the community rooms.
 - e. Program analysis and development: Chelsea
 - i. The Marketing Coordinator is working on improving the activities/program guide.
 - ii. The department is also working on adding and implementing new programs.
 - f. Trails: James & Dana
 - i. New trails have been completed on Red Mountain and South Canyon
