



## MINUTES

### City of Glenwood Springs Arts and Culture Board Meeting of January 15 6:00 PM Glenwood Springs Community Center

1. Call to order: 6:09 pm
2. Roll Call:
  - a. Staff: Brian Smith, Cristi Newton
  - b. City Council Liaison: Shelley Kaup

3. Citizen Comments:
  - a. Jim Pomey AKA Jammin Jim came to present some ideas for the area under the new Grand Avenue Bridge. He would like to promote locals entertaining tourists in our downtown. Jim will seek local sponsorships for the program. The Board was in support of Jim's ideas and asked that Jim supply a proposal to City Staff and request he be placed on the February agenda so that action can be taken.
4. Approval of November Minutes
  - a. Bonnie made the motion to approve. Mary second. All approved, none opposed.
5. Glenwood Post Article
  - a. Mary provided the Board with the most recent draft of the post article.
  - b. There was some concern from City Administration about the writing and publishing of a regular article. Discussion on purpose of article and whether this will set a precedent for other boards and commissions. Suggestion: a meeting should be set with City Administration and a couple representatives from the Board.
  - c. Discussion on the mentioning of the Arts Council in the article. Stefanie will reword the second paragraph and send it out for review.
  - d. Discussion on remainder of article. Revision suggestions were given to Mary. A final draft will be shared with the group for final approval after edits are completed.
6. Children's Chorale
  - a. The Colorado Springs Children's Chorale will be in Glenwood April 26th – 28<sup>th</sup>. The group is made up of 35 middle school aged children. They will be putting on

several concerts around the valley while they are here. They would like to teach a masters class on the 27<sup>th</sup> for up to 50 local youth. The class would finish with a concert. Cost is approximately \$2,500. They would like to offer it to the students for free.

- b. Discussion on program and how Board can assist. Jonathon requested the Boards assistance in getting the word out to the community.
7. Committee Reports
    - a. Public Relations: Byana spoke to the Chamber and they do not yet have a plan for a community calendar widget yet. She asked that they keep her informed of any updates.
    - b. Public Art: The committee will continue to work at mapping out and logging of all public art that is currently in Glenwood Springs
      - i. The suggestion to use a phone app called Wonder Wander Public Art Adventure which is an interactive app geared toward families exploring art in communities.
      - ii. The City does have a GIS program that would be a great tool to use for mapping and planning.
  8. Director Updates
    - a. Art Center:
      - i. AC install project is going forward and will be happening over the next few weeks.
      - ii. Network drops are going to be complete over the next couple weeks as well.
      - iii. The City is looking into grants to help funding future improvements. Discussion on the possibility of creation of a 501c3
    - b. Public Art Charrettes
      - i. There were 2 charrettes for the public art piece that will be placed on the North Landing area. The next step is for the artist to create a small version of the proposed piece for the steering committee to approve.
    - c. Everyone is invited to the Community Art Center Open house on February 2<sup>nd</sup> from noon – 3pm.
