Grand Avenue Bridge Opening, Holiday Lighting and Wine Walk Event

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – The City of Glenwood Springs and downtown businesses invite residents and visitors to raise their glasses to the new Grand Avenue Bridge at the Holiday Lighting & Wine Walk, Friday, Nov. 24 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. This free, family-friendly event coincides with the annual lighting ceremony at the Hotel Colorado and will include a lighting of the new Grand Avenue pedestrian bridge, as well as a wine walk and ice carving demonstration.

The wine walk will take place at wide array of local businesses throughout downtown Glenwood Springs and will consist of wine, liquor, cider, and non-alcoholic beverage tastings and bottle sales.
