City of Glenwood Springs allocates \$148,800 in Financial Advisory Board Grants

Glenwood Springs, CO – On June 3, Glenwood Springs City Council allocated \$148,800 in Financial Advisory Board (FAB) grant funding to 19 non-profit and community organizations. Each year, the City of Glenwood Springs allocates a portion of sales tax revenues from its A&I and Tourism Funds for human services, special events, tourism promotion and other public purposes as City Council deems appropriate.

“These grant recipients provide a wide range of valuable services for our community,” said Mayor Jonathan Godes. “From youth programs to environmental work, financial assistance and fun, City Council is honored to assist these organizations in their important work.”
