

RESOLUTION 2022-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Glenwood Springs is an eligible applicant for a grant awarded by the U.S. Department of Transportation (“DOT”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Glenwood Springs is submitting a grant application to DOT for \$600,000 in funding, to support additional safety data analysis and preliminary planning and design of projects, operational changes and public campaigns to improve pedestrian, transit rider and driver safety within Glenwood Springs, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs supports the completion of the project if a grant is awarded by DOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, RESOLVES THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated as findings by the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs strongly supports the proposal to the Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program and will appropriate \$120,000 as matching funds for the \$600,000 grant.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs will authorize the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded pursuant to a Grant Agreement with DOT.

Section 4. If the grant is awarded, the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs hereby authorizes the Mayor or Mayor Pro-Tem to sign the grant agreement with DOT.
